While she was expiencing bleeding, I didn't know who to call or what steps to take. We could only pray together and wait for the sun to rise. We rushed to the hospital that morning, and after the ultrasound, the doctor confirmed, "The baby is safe." I praise the Lord for His constant protection, enduring faithfulness, and caring hand over our family.

Last month, we had a pastors' fellowship conference at Bethany Baptist Church (Sending Church), Yangon, Myanmar. I was truly blessed during this time.
